**Title:** I AM the Resurrection and the Life

**Text:** John 11:1-46

**Theme:** Jesus is resurrection and life for all who believe.

**One:** The Understanding of Resurrection and Life.

- Delay, but not without purpose
- Suffering, but not without glory
- Glory, but not without love
- Truth, but not without faith
- Life, but not without death
- Sorrow, but not without hope
- Death, but not without resurrection






**Two:** The Fullness of Resurrection and Life.

- At Calvary
- At regeneration
- At the last day

## Further Study / Application

- *“They received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so” ~ Acts 17:11*
- Consider the following symbols as study tools for any text you approach: the light bulb (something to see), the question mark (something to ask), the arrow (something to do), the Bible (somewhere else to look), & the person (someone to tell).
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- Read three verses about the glory of God in your life: Psalm 81:10, Matthew 13:58, John 11:40. Read Is 30:18 and see how it overlaps with John 11:5-6.
- How does 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 help us understand life and death in John 11?
- Regarding the resurrection, consider John 5:24-29 With 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18.
- Read John 11:4 and note the words “through it”. What is the “it” in your life that can glorify Christ?
