One: The Understanding of Resurrection and Life.

- Delay, but not without purpose
- Suffering, but not without glory
- Glory, but not without love
- Truth, but not without faith
- · Life, but not without death
- · Sorrow, but not without hope
- Death, but not without resurrection

Two: The Fullness of Resurrection and Life.

- At Calvary
- At regeneration
- At the last day
